Services for Mr. A. Paul Gilbert, Jr., age 87, of Hideaway are scheduled for 2:30 P.M. Monday in the Lindale First United Methodist Church with Rev. Bryan Brown and Rev. Paul Kethley officiating. Mr. Gilbert died Friday morning, March 17, 2006 in a Lindale Nursing Center. He was born January 19, 1919 in Bridgeport, Connecticut and was formerly of Plano and Longview before moving to Hideaway in 1985. Mr. Gilbert attended the Centenary College in Shreveport and the University of Texas at Austin. He was a veteran of WW II serving as a Staff Sergeant in the 5th Army in North Africa and Italy, and was proud to serve his country. He was a member of the Lindale First United Methodist Church, which he dearly loved. Paul was born "Yankee" but a Texan at heart. He worked for the Sun Oil Co. and retired after 38 years of service. His career with Sun Oil started in Delhi, LA and included West Texas and Dallas, and ended with his retirement in Longview in 1984. When not at Hideaway, Paul and his wife Loretta of 16 years loved to spend time in Ruidoso, NM. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Helen F. Gilbert and a step-son, William Bradford Morgan.

His survivors include his wife, Mrs. Loretta J. Gilbert of Hideaway; children, A. Paul Gilbert, III of Houston, Stephen C. Gilbert and wife Janet of Highlands Ranch, CO, John P. Gilbert and wife Laura of Waco, Elaine C. Ard and

husband Chip of Tulsa, OK; step-son John Mark Morgan and wife Carole of Dallas; sister-in-law Mrs. June Sinclair of Hideaway; grandchildren Trent Gilbert, Kira Gilbert, Tonna Gilbert, Travis Gilbert, Emily Gilbert, Clara Ard and Campbell Ard.
