Funeral services for Mr. A. L. Hagg, age 87, of Hideaway are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Thursday, September 22, 2011 in the First United Methodist Church Lindale with Dr. Jack Cox and Rev. Wayne Flowers officiating. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Mr. Hagg died Friday, September 16, 2011 in Hideaway. He was born on June 9, 1924 in Dallas, Texas, the son of the late Albert Leroy, Sr. & Gladys Munk Hagg and was formerly of Dallas before moving to Hideaway. Mr. Hagg served in the United States Air Force during World War II and the Korean War as a pilot flying a P-47 Thunderbolt. He retired in 1984 after working for American Airlines as a pilot for 33 years and was a member of the P-47 Thunderbolt Pilots Association, Elks Lodge in Dallas and First United Methodist Church Lindale. He was also very active in all the social activities in the community of Hideaway.
