Who will ever forget his reply when you and Mother asked him what is that all over his Easter outfit?

You not only looked like my Memaw in recent years, you were so much like her in many other ways. You could cook the most wonderful meals and could make anything grow and flourish ... what a tribute that is ❤️

Aunt Alice, this is not goodbye, it's so long for now because I have the assurance that I will see you again one day ❤️
