He was a baker for the Veteran's Hospital in Waco and Ellington Air Force Base in Texas. After retiring from civil service, he joined Ann in the antique business. They maintained shops for 50 years in Waco, Dallas, Pasadena, Houston and finally Lindale, Texas.

Mr. Soules was proud to have been a member and past-president of the Houston Antique Dealers Association, and a current member of the Swan-Woodsprings Methodist Church, Friends of the Lindale Library and the Lindale

Chamber of Commerce.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, Charles Warren "C.W." Soules and Arthur Soules and wife of 69 1/2 years, Annamargaret Soules. Mr. Soules is survived by his daughter & son-in-law, Kay Lynn and R. Hugh Soules of Lindale; many nieces and nephews and many friends. He is loved and will be missed.
