Mr. Dowell was born December 10, 1935 in Golden, Texas the son of the late Thurman and Rosa Lee (Young) Dowell. He passed away Sunday, January 5, 2014 in a Tyler hospital. Mr. Dowell lived in Hideaway for the past 16 years. He was a member of the North Richland Hills Chamber of Commerce, President of the Dallas Jaycees, and also an active member of the Memphis, Tennessee Jaycees. Mr. Dowell's career as a petroleum engineer included working in the oil fields of Saudi Arabia and in off shore drilling in the North Sea of Denmark. In 1970 he was given the award from University of Corpus Christi as Distinguished Alumni. Mr. Dowell was a member of the 18 Hole Men, and the Hideaway Men's Golf Association. He was a member of the Lakeside Class at the Hideaway Community Church.
