Andrea June Myrick, known as June by her friends and family, passed into glory to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on December 26, 2025, in Tyler, Texas. She was 79 years old. June was born in Hattiesburg, Mississippi on December 10, 1946, to Leroy Andrew Myers and Georgie Belle (Harrington). She grew up in Mobile, Alabama until she met the love of her life, Aubrey Wayne Myrick, at William Carey College in Hattiesburg. According to Wayne, she winked at him across the cafeteria and they were married a few short months later, on January 27, 1968. They were together for almost 58 years living in many places around the world during Wayne's 20-year Air Force career. They retired in Fort Worth, Texas and lived there for 36 years. Most recently, they have lived in Lindale, Texas for two years. June was a retired executive secretary from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth.
