Ann Massey (76) passed away on the morning of May 1, 2010 in Tyler, Texas. Originally from Fort Smith, Arkansas, Nyla Ann North set herself apart by becoming extraordinarily accomplished for a woman of her time. Graduating from the University of Arkansas in 1955, she used her fluency in Spanish and sign language to work as a speech therapist. After relocating to Grand Prairie, TX in 1957, Ann spent 26 years as a valuable employee of the Texas Employment Commission.
