



Annie Mae Morris

December 21, 1920 - March 30, 2017

Annie Mae Morris of Tyler, Texas passed away on Thursday, March 30, 2017, just three years and two hundred sixty-five days short of her one-hundred-year goal. Annie Mae entered this world on December 21, 1920, in Mount Pleasant, Texas. She was one of ten children born to Charles Thomas Adams, a farmer, and Bulah Mae Poag. At the tender age of sixteen, she married Jesse Marvin Morris, a widower with four children. Marvin and Annie Mae had four more children together. A lifelong Democrat, Annie Mae worked for more than twenty years at Buckner Baptist Children's Home in Lubbock, Texas. She possessed a wry sense of humor and an almost relentless drive to be sociable. She was an active member and Sunday school teacher at both Broadview Baptist Church in Lubbock, Texas and New Harmony Baptist Church in Tyler, Texas. In her seventies, Annie Mae battled breast cancer and won. She went on to live a long life filled with work that was rewarding, friendships that she cherished, and a family who loved her. Annie Mae is preceded in death by her parents, all nine of her siblings, her husband Marvin, and two of her children, Joe Henry Morris of Lubbock, Texas and Dorothy Thompson of Fairfield, California. She is survived by three sons and three daughters: Jesse Dean Morris of Nacogdoches, Texas; Charles Thomas Morris of Tyler, Texas; James Marvin Morris of San Diego, California; Gloria McBride of Sherman, Texas; Sandra Berry of Tyler, Texas; and Carol Truskosky of Tyler, Texas. Annie Mae also leaves behind twenty-eight grandchildren, forty great-grandchildren, a handful of great great-

grandchildren, numerous nieces and nephews, and a beloved cat "Tinker."

on Tuesday, April 4, 2017, at 2:00 PM with Pastor Robbie Caldwell officiating.
