



## Anthony Wayne Brundidge

January 14, 1914 - February 4, 2004

Services for Mr. Anthony Wayne Brundidge, Sr. age 90, of Tyler are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Saturday in the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home Chapel in Lindale with Rev. Randy Potter officiating. Interment will follow in the Rose Hill Cemetery in Tyler. Mr. Brundidge died Wednesday evening in a Lindale Nursing Center surrounded by a group of loved ones.
