Bennie James McFadden, 83, of Tyler, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, September 27, 2014, surrounded by his loving family. Services will be held on Thursday, October 2, at 3:00 p.m. in the chapel of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home with Pastor Pike Wisner officiating.

Ben was born in New Harmony, TX, on October 10, 1930, to the late Leonard Franklin McFadden and Georgia Cates McFadden of Mount Sylvan, TX. He graduated from Lindale High School, Tyler Junior College and is an alumni of East Texas State University in Commerce. He was a true patriot and served his country in the Army intelligence division for 2 years in Tokyo, Japan, from 1953-1955 during the Korean War. He married the love of his life, Molly Linnstaedter McFadden, on June 14, 1958, and together they raised 3 daughters. He had a lifelong career in the insurance industry earning several awards and distinctions. Among them: President of Tyler Association of Life Underwriters, Life Member of the Texas Leaders Round Table, Director of Texas Association of Life Underwriters and American National President's Club. Ben was also active in many civic organizations including the Tyler Evening Lions Club, Shriners and the Masonic Lodge. He was instrumental in starting UsTOO in Tyler – a support group for those affected by prostate cancer – as well as helping arrange the very first Race for the Cure in Tyler which supports breast cancer awareness. He was a lifelong member of First Baptist Church, Tyler. He enjoyed water skiing, hunting, golfing, softball and watching the Cowboys. He was a loving husband, father, brother, uncle and a

friend to many. His infectious sense of humor, quick wit and ability to find the silver lining in all things will forever be missed. Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Wilma McFadden Starnes. He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Molly, daughters Cheryl McFadden of Dallas, Jill McFadden of Tyler and Kaye McFadden of N Truro, MA. Also surviving are his niece, Gaye Starnes, and his nephew, Mac Starnes. Ben also has one aunt, Dorothy McFadden Pitcher. The family also wishes to express gratitude to Deborah Martin and James Brantley for their love and support during his illness.
