Bias Ben Lott, 61, of Lindale, Texas passed away on Friday, March 6, 2015 at ETMC Trauma ICU in Tyler, Texas. Lott's daughter was at his bedside attending him with a tender and compassionate manner.

Lott leaves his daughter and son-in-law, Heather Lott-Carver and Josh Carver; granddaughter Ayla and step-grandchildren; aunts, Molly Lott Hall of Tyler; Barbara Lott of Lindale; many cousins and a host of other relatives. Bias was preceded in death by his parents B.K. and La Jane Wells Lott of Lindale; grandparents Billie and Chester Wells of Lindale; and Ben Knox and Sally Perryman Lott of Winona, Texas.

Born in Tyler March 10, 1953, Lott was raised in Lindale and was an avid member of the LHS tennis team. Upon graduation from Lindale High School he attended TJC obtaining a degree in Chemistry. While enlisted in the United States Army he was stationed in Alaska and Georgia; upon discharge, Bias received an Honorable Discharge.
