Services for Bill Parrott, age 86 of Lindale, are scheduled for 10:30 AM Thursday, June 23, 2016 at the First Baptist Church in Lindale with Dr. Mark Morman officiating. Interment will follow in the Carmel Cemetery with services under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale. Mr. Parrott died Monday, June 20, 2016 at his residence in Lindale. He was born in Tyler on May 10, 1930 to the late Roscoe and Edith (Hall) Parrott and served in the United States Navy during the Korean War. He moved to Lindale in 1963 where as a builder, his construction company helped Lindale and Hideaway Lake grow and expand. He was a member and served as a Deacon for many years at the Lindale First Baptist Church. Mr. Parrott was also a member of the Rotary Club and a member of the Lindale Chamber of Commerce. He was awarded the Citizen of the Year award in 2007 by the Lindale Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Parrott was the Founder and Primary Benefactor of the Old Mill Pond Museum in Lindale. His passion was flying his airplane all over the country and to Mexico. Mr. Parrott was very dedicated to supporting missions at home and abroad. His love for Lindale will always be remembered as he will be missed by many.

Mr. Parrott is survived by his wife of 58 years, Gloria Parrott of Lindale; daughter, Donna Parrott Morman and husband, Dr. Mark Morman of Waco; grandson, Trent Morman of Waco; and brother, Dr. Bob Parrott of Longview. 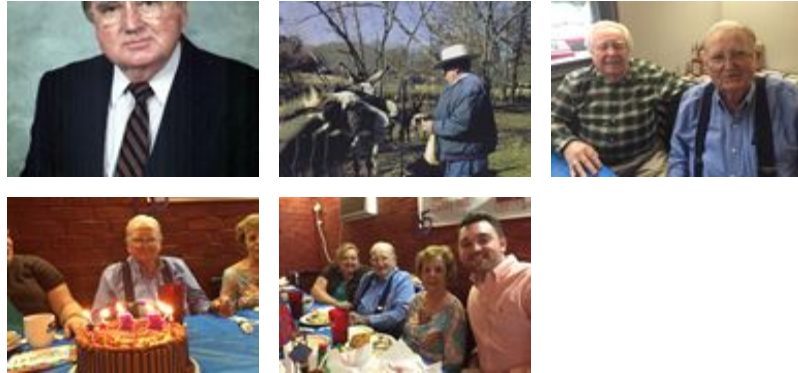
