Memorial services for Mr. Bob R. Morgan, age 79, of Hideaway, Texas are scheduled for 11:00 A.M. Wednesday, May 21, 2014 in the Hideaway Lake Community Church with Rev. Hershale Sanders and Rev. Paul Garrison officiating. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Mr. Morgan died Monday, May 19, 2014 at his residence in Hideaway. He was born in Crockett, Texas on January 22, 1935 to the late Thomas Leonard and Helen Marie (Sims) Morgan and was formerly of Houston, Texas before moving to Hideaway in 1992. Mr. Morgan had previously worked for Houston Lighting and Power before retiring in 1992.
