Graveside services for Bobby Derrill Brisendine, age 90, of Lindale, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Monday, January 27, 2020 at the Union Chapel Cemetery near Van, Texas with Bro. Ira Lynn officiating. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale, Texas. Mr. Brisendine died Thursday, January 23, 2020 in a Tyler hospice center. He was born in Mexia, Texas on June 28, 1929 to the late Perry Orville and Iva Jewel (Arnett) Brisendine and was formerly of Plano, Texas before moving to the Lindale area in 1984. Mr. Brisendine served in the United States Army Air Corp during World War II and retired after 35 years as an electronic engineer for Ratheon in Plano, Texas. He was a member of the South Main Church of Christ in Lindale and was preceded in death by a son, Bobby Don Brisendine in 2006.
