



Bobby Ray McCoy

August 19, 1941 - August 1, 2007

Services for Mr. Bobby Ray McCoy, Sr., age 65, of Tyler are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Sunday, August 5, 2007 in the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home Chapel with the Honorable Lyle Stubbs, Trinity Mayor officiating. Interment will follow in the Sand Flat Cemetery with services under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Mr. McCoy died Wednesday, August 1, 2007 in a Tyler hospice center. He was born on August 19, 1941 in Hugo, Oklahoma, the son of Robert Whitfield and Dessie Ward McCoy and was a lifelong resident of Trinity, Texas before moving to Tyler 2 years ago.
