



C. R. "Rudy" Gimble

October 4, 1924 - March 2, 2019

Graveside services for Mr. C. R. "Rudy" Gimble, age 94 of Tyler, are scheduled for 3:30 PM Wednesday, March 6, 2019 at the New Harmony Cemetery in the New Harmony Community with Pastor Larry Craig and Pastor Brandon Holiski officiating. Mr. Gimble died Saturday, March 2, 2019 in an assisted living center in Tyler. He was born October 4, 1924 to the late Paul and Dollie Frances (Cates) Gimble. Mr. Gimble was raised in New Harmony and a longtime resident of Tyler. He served in the Navy during WWII and was a deacon of the Southern Oaks Baptist Church in Tyler.
