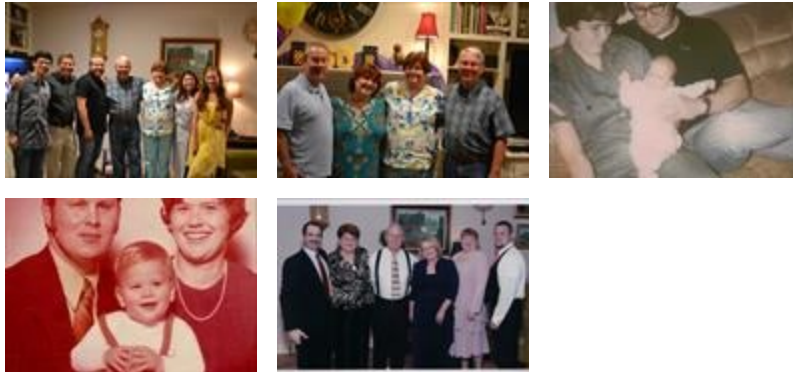

“ We have known Carolyn & Bob for almost 50 years! We met them in Miami Florida in 1974 when Bob came to work at Florida Power & Light Company. He and I worked in the same department. I had recently graduated from college and had been there about a year. Carolyn was coming in with Michael in a few days. Bob had been staying in a hotel that week and had checked out on Friday since the movers were expected in on Friday. Unfortunately, the movers for the sellers and the movers for the buyers were both running behind. Bob did not have a place to spend the weekend. My southern intuition and Bob's southern intuition knew we could trust each other, and he came to our apartment for the weekend. He slept on an old couch we had in the living room. Our decor at that time was early attic!! That weekend started a relationship that has endured the test of time.

Bob and Carolyn were like a brother and sister to us. We have been through sickness, deaths, births, miscarriages, surgeries, marriages and the list is too long to tell here. Bob and I talked every day for the 22 days Carolyn was in Methodist Hospital ICU in Houston. Those last few days were horrible waiting for Jesus to come and escort Carolyn home.
