



## Charles R. Ivy

March 6, 1940 - July 15, 2008

Funeral services for Mr. Charles R. Ivy, age 68, of Lindale are scheduled for 10:00 A.M. Friday, July 18, 2008 at the New Harmony Baptist Church with Bro. Grady McDonald and Daniel Baker officiating.
