



Charles Ray Garrett

September 1, 1934 - December 6, 2006

Services for Mr. Charles Ray Garrett, age 72, of Lindale are scheduled for 2:30 P.M. Sunday, December 10, 2006 in the Lindale Church of Christ with Brother Wayne Fancher and Brother Dan Shipley officiating. Interment will follow in the Lindale City Cemetery under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Mr. Garrett died Wednesday, December 6, 2006 in a Tyler hospital. He was born September 1, 1934 in Ennis, Texas to Lawton and Inez Morman Garrett and lived the majority of his life in Lindale. Mr. Garrett was a member of the Lindale Church of Christ and was a veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving in the United States Air Force. While serving with the Air Force for 15 years, Charles served with the Tactical Air Command and received the Small Arms Marksmanship Expert Medal and the Fidelity Efficiency Honor Medal. He was also a graduate of Lindale High School. Mr. Garrett was a former Fire Chief for the Lindale Volunteer Fire Department and served on the Lindale City Council for 7 years. He was a former employee of the Forestry Service, General Manager for Allen's Tire Company and currently employed by the P. & O. Motor Company in Lindale. While with the Forestry Service, he received a certificate of appreciation for developing news stories about the Forestry Service personnel and activities. He was preceded in death by his parents, Sons, Michael Garrett and Tony Garrett and by a Brother, Billy Garrett.
