



Clarlynn Jones Arbuckle

A memorial service for Clarlynn Jones Arbuckle, age 84 of Lindale, Texas, is scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Saturday, May 2, 2026, at the Swan Wood Springs Methodist Church in Swan. A private interment will be held at Lindale City Cemetery.

Clarlynn passed away on Sunday, March 29, 2026, in Tyler, Texas. She was born on October 25, 1941, in Terrell, Texas to the late Clarence Jesse and Edna Juanita (Clark) Terry. Clarlynn was a lifelong resident of Lindale and a member of the Swan Wood Springs Methodist Church. After many years of service, Clarlynn retired as Registrar at the University of Texas at Tyler. 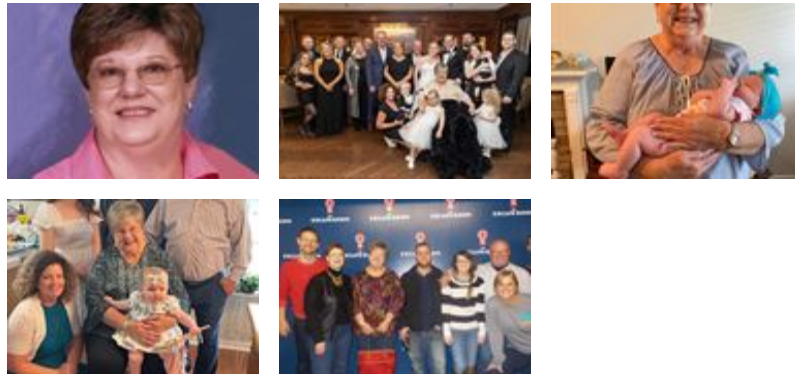
