Immediately prior to his deployment overseas, he married Christyne Marie on August 3, 1951 in San Diego, California. Their romance and loving marriage spanned 64 wonderful years filled with joy and adventure. Wayne deeply loved all of his family and extended family. His son Mark W Gilbert and two grandchildren, Hunter M Gilbert and Austin M Gilbert provided him so many blessings and indescribable pride and happiness. He also was blessed with incredible friends with whom he shared great times and adventures, many of whom he has now joined in Heaven for even greater times. Wayne was a compassionate and caring person with quick wit and the ability to tell awesome stories. He was an antique car enthusiast, an incredible handyman

as well as a lover of animals and the disadvantaged. After being honorably discharged, Wayne and Chris settled in Tyler, Texas. He began a long career as an accountant with Texas Power and Light that spanned 37 years. Building on the foundation of faith instilled by his parents he began a long and blessed journey with the Swan-Wood Springs United Methodist Church where he served as Treasurer for many years. He also joined the St Johns Masonic Lodge of Tyler. He also began a long association with the Kiwanis Club in various cities in East Texas including Tyler where he served as President among other offices. He was also a proud member of the Disabled American Veterans and the American Legion. Wayne was preceded in death by his parents, Etta Virginia Sitton Gilbert and Claude Ernest Gilbert.
