



Claude B. Jordan

September 24, 1929 - May 17, 2013

Services for Mr. Claude B. Jordan, Sr., age 83, of Lindale, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 A.M. Tuesday at the Central Baptist Church in Lindale with Rev. Mark Thompson, Rev. Byron Howard and Rev. David "Took" Martin officiating. Interment will follow in the Lindale City Cemetery under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Mr. Jordan died Friday, May 17, 2013 in a Tyler hospital. He was born on September 24, 1929 in Smith County, Texas to the late Frank Wesley and Launa (Sitton) Jordan and was a lifelong resident of Lindale. Mr. Jordan served in the United States Army and owned and operated P&O Motors in Lindale. He was a member of the Lindale Masonic Lodge #848 where he served as Past Master, Past President of Lions Club and member of the Order of the Eastern Star. Mr. Jordan had also been past fire chief for the Lindale Volunteer Fire Department and was a member of the Damascus Baptist Church. He was preceded in death by his wife, Imogene (Black) Jordan in 1991 and daughter-in-law, Deborah Jordan in 1993.
