He was born on December 24, 1934 in Starrville, Texas to Clinton Harvey and Ada Mae Tinney Bartley and lived the majority of his life in Lindale. Mr. Bartley was a graduate of Lindale High School and played football for HCJC and Midwestern. He was a veteran serving in the US Army and was a member of the South Main Church of Christ in Lindale where he was a Bible Class teacher. Mr. Bartley was very active in the Lindale Community serving on numerous boards and committees including President of the Lindale Baseball Association, President of the Athletic Booster Club, Band Booster Club, Past President and Board member of the Lindale Chamber of Commerce, and Past President of the Lindale Rotary Club where he was a Paul Harris Fellow. He also was a member of the Board of Directors of Lindale National Bank, Executive Vice-President of First Service Bank, and served on the Lindale Economic Development Board.
