



## Clyde Carlisle

September 7, 1931 - October 26, 2009

Funeral services for Mr. Clyde Carlisle, age 78, of Lindale are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Thursday, October 29, 2009 in the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home Chapel in Lindale. Interment will follow in the Hopewell Cemetery with services under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Mr. Carlisle died Monday, October 26, 2009 in a Tyler hospice center. He was born in Smith County on September 7, 1931, the son of Coy Onice and Lora Emaline Crow Carlisle and was formerly of Mesquite before returning in 1999 to Lindale. Mr. Carlisle served in the United States Army during the Korean War in the 13th Battalion of Combat Engineers and retired in 1987 after 34 years with TXU. He was a member of the Mt.
