Mr. Daniel Edward Gannaway passed away September 12, 2005 at his home in Hideaway, Texas. He was born January 27, 1923 in Dallas, Texas to the late Robert Edward and Lydia Lorena Morrison Gannaway. Dan was a graduate of Irving High School in Irving, Texas and SMU in Dallas. He served in the Pacific as a Navy torpedo bomber pilot during World War II aboard the carrier USS Hancock.
