



Daniel Baker

November 10, 1941 - April 12, 2020

A private graveside service for Daniel Owen Baker, age 78 of Tyler, Texas, will be held at Red Springs Cemetery with Bro. Robbie Caldwell officiating. A public memorial service will be held at a later date.

Daniel was born November 10, 1941 to David and Ola Baker in Lee Town, Mississippi and passed away April 12, 2020 at his home near Tyler, Texas. His dad was away during World War II for almost three years of his early childhood. Daniel was raised in church, and was born again as a youth, placing his faith in The Lord Jesus Christ. Daniel obtained a master's degree in Physics, at Mississippi State University. He met Fay Katherin Hamilton at church, and they were married for 54 years. His favorite vacation was to Hawaii for their fiftieth wedding anniversary. Daniel served in the Louisiana National Guard for six years, finishing his enlistment as a Staff Sergeant. He spent his professional career working for United Gas and later, Pennzoil, in research laboratories. After retiring from Pennzoil, Daniel returned to his childhood roots of farming. He raised and sold vegetables in farmer's markets in the Tyler area for almost twenty years. Over the decades, Daniel served as a deacon and a very knowledgeable Sunday school teacher at Rose Park Baptist Church in Shreveport, Louisiana; Northside Baptist Church in Conroe, Texas; and at both New Harmony and later Red Springs Baptist Churches in East Texas. Daniel also served as music director at Red Springs. Daniel often visited the sick in hospitals and led visitation programs for the church. He attended many extracurricular activities of his grandkids and he enjoyed

taking them on trips.

Daniel leaves behind his devoted wife, Fay, his son Jonathan and daughter Shannon Levee and son in law James Levee of Winona Texas. Two grandchildren, Carson Levee and Jessica Levee Kohutek and husband Jonathan Kohutek. Honorary granddaughter Bailey Kemp and husband Kyle Kemp. Two brothers, Lanny and wife Mary Jane Baker and Winfred and wife Patty Baker. He also leaves behind four in laws: Clifford Hamilton, Tillie Lilly, Spencer and Doshua Hamilton and numerous nephews and nieces and their spouses plus numerous great nephews and nieces and many friends. He was preceded in death by his parents, David and Ola Baker and his sister Vivian McDonald and in laws John McDonald, Tommy Lilly and Wanda Hamilton.
