DAVID GEORGE HANEY, M.D., of Lindale, Texas passed away peacefully at his home on November 21, 2010 at the age of 79.

David was born in Duluth, Minnesota to Harry & Ruth Haney. He graduated from the University of Minnesota Medical School in 1957 followed by an internship at Wayne County General Hospital in Eloise, Michigan and residency in ophthalmology at Tulane University EENT Hospital, New Orleans, Louisiana.

Dr. Haney served with his wife as a missionary at the Lighthouse for Christ Eye Center in Mombasa, Kenya, East Africa from 1981 to 1995. In 1995 he was awarded the J. Lawton Smith Award for 1ST class medicine given in a spirit of love.

Residing in Lindale since 2004, he was part of the Calvary Chapel family, member of the Lindale Rotary Club and the Christian Ophthalmology Society.

Dr. David Haney was preceded in death by his son Scott. He is survived by his wife, Glenna; children, David Jr. & Cindy, Graham & Tami, Jason & Maureen, Grant, Lisa, Desmonde & Dana, Margo & Russ, Andre & Paul; fifteen grandchildren and six great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday November 27, at 2:00 P.M. at the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home, 206 W. South Street, Lindale, TX. Pastor Tim Burns will be officiating. Viewing will be on Friday November 26 from 6:00 to 8:00 P.M.
