Don Harvey, age 74 of Hideaway, TX passed away Wednesday, February 17, 2021 at his home. He was born October 20, 1946 in Wichita, Kansas to the late Forrest L. and Lola Mae (Blue) Harvey. Don was a lifelong resident of Wichita, Kansas before moving to Hideaway 5 years ago. He attended Sunday School at the First United Methodist Church in Lindale and was a member of the Hideaway Lake Kiwanis Club, and the Dinner and Dance Club of Hideaway Lake.
