Funeral services for Donald Elbert Awbrey, age 77, of Lufkin are scheduled for Sunday, November 15, 2009 at 2:00 P.M. in the Spirit Life Worship Center in Hudson, Texas. Burial with military honors will follow in the Largent Cemetery in Lufkin, Texas with Pastor Jess Slider and Pastor Syble Stone officiating.
