



## Donald Rex Ford

September 24, 1930 - March 10, 2011

Graveside Services for Mr. Donald Rex Ford, age 80, of Lindale, are scheduled for 10:45 AM on Tuesday, March 15, 2011 in the DFW National Cemetery with Rev. Wes Bynum officiating. Services are under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale.

Mr. Ford died on Thursday, March 10, 2011 in a Tyler Hospital. 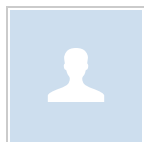
