A celebration of life for Doris Bhael Clements age 100 of Hideaway will be held on Saturday December 13, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. at the Hideaway Lake Community Church with the Reverend Paul Garrison officiating. Doris Clements was born in rural Beebe, Arkansas to Sam and Lola Bhael on July 23, 1914. She was preceded in death by her parents, a sister Inez Bhael , a brother Norris Bhael and her husband Clemo. After studying at Paris Junior College, she became an accomplished dance instructor in Paris and Brownsville specializing in tap dance. She continued to love dancing throughout her life and was always ready to kick up her heels on the dance floor. While in college, she met the love of her life, Ulmon "Clemo" Clements and they were married on May 29, 1937. They were active for many years in the newspaper publishing business in Carthage and Lewisville. Through this vehicle they became associated with many prominent figures such as General Douglas McArthur, President John F. Kennedy and President Lyndon Johnson. After retiring in 1972, they moved to Hideaway Lake in East Texas where they were involved in the creation of the Hideaway Lake News. An active member of the Community, she was a charter member of the Hideaway Lake Community Church, taught water aerobics, belonged to several bridge groups and enjoyed line dancing. Doris lived a life surrounded by many friends who enjoyed her quick wit and enthusiasm for life. She will always be remembered for generous contributions to many worthwhile causes and was always eager to help those in need. In July Doris celebrated her 100th

birthday with a joyous celebration and lots of friends. She is survived by a nephew, Walter Clements of Dallas and a niece, Linda Clements Mathews of Red Bluff, California. If desired, donations may be made in her memory to The Building Fund of the Hideaway Lake Community Church.
