



Douglas Scott Burleson

January 7, 1945 - July 4, 2014

Services for Mr. Douglas Scott Burleson, age 69, of Hideaway, are scheduled for 11AM on Monday, July 7, 2014, in the Lindale First United Methodist Church with Rev. Mr. Burleson died on Friday, July 4, 2014 in the Hospice Homeplace in Tyler. 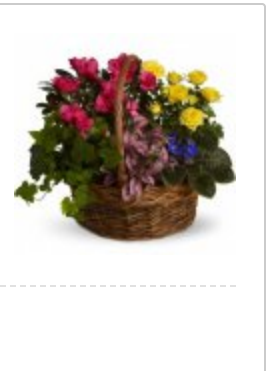
