January 16, 1921 - December 23, 2016

Funeral services for Mr. Floyd F. Anderson, age 95, of Lindale, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. Tuesday, December 27, 2016 at the First Baptist Church Lindale with Rev. Mr. Anderson died Friday, December 23, 2016 at his residence in Lindale. He was born in Jack County, Texas on January 16, 1921 to the late Harmon Edgar and Myrtle Ada (Menasco) Anderson. 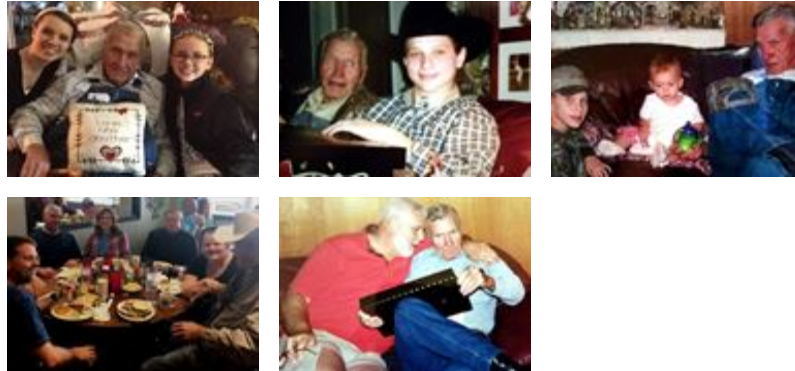
