April 3, 1937 - September 30, 2005

Funeral services for Mr. Freddie "Big Daddy" Snowden, age 68, of Lindale are scheduled for Monday, October 3, 2005 at 3:00 P.M. in the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home Chapel with Bro. James Cowart, Rev. Byron Howard & Son-in-Law Robert Walters officiating. A private graveside will follow in Tyler at the Rose Hill Cemetery under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale. Mr. Snowden died Friday evening in a Tyler hospital. He was born April 3, 1937 in Lufkin, Texas to Fred Forest and Emory Dee Thompson Snowden and was a longtime resident of Lindale. Mr. Snowden attended Central Baptist Church of Lindale, was a member of the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association and coached Little League Baseball for the past 7 years. He was a retired real estate broker and for the last several years substituted at E. J. Moss Intermediate School in O. C. S. In his earlier years he was a stunt man appearing in the motion picture "The Horse Soldiers" with John Wayne.

He is survived by his Wife, Shirley Ann Snowden of Lindale; 2 Daughters & Son-in-law, Kim Snowden of Lindale and Kelly & Robert Walters of Hillsboro; Grandchildren, Bennett & Holly Redford of Gatesville, Aaron Beaty & Laird Snowden, both of Lindale, Seth Capps, Lane Walters, Nash Walters, Gage Walters and Kale Walters, all of Hillsboro, and Robbie Walters & Summer Walters, both of Tyler.
