Funeral services for Dustin “Gene” Lowe age 83 of Lindale, Texas are scheduled for 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 9, 2022, at the Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home Chapel in Lindale with Pastor Craig Lacy officiating. Interment will follow at Jamestown Cemetery in Smith County. Gene passed away Thursday, February 3, 2022, at Hospice Home Place in Tyler. He was born at home in the Wisdom Temple community outside of Van on December 17, 1938 to Roberta Lee Lowe and the late John Shirley Lowe. Raised by his grandparents after his mother remarried, he graduated from Van High School in 1958. A true rancher at heart, Gene embarked on a career in the cattle industry working for COBA/Select Sires, retiring from the Tyler office with over 40 years of service.
