Gerald F. "Gerry" Schomers died Friday, July 11, 2003.

Gerry was born December 17, 1927 in LaCrosse, Wisconsin, the son of Frank and Mildred Schomers. Gerry graduated from St. Patrick's High School in Perry, IA in 1946. He was an army veteran of the Korean War. He attended in University of Iowa and was a member of the SAE social fraternity.

Gerry started his career in the insurance claims business as an independent adjuster with the J. Lee Hill Claims Service in Des Moines and Ottumwa, IA. He later became Vice President of Claims for the Transport Insurance Company in Dallas, Texas. He retired in 1995, after spending the last 5 years of his career with the law firm of Martin, Farr, Miller and Grau in Dallas. He retired to live at Hide-a-Way Lake, Texas.

Gerry was a member of St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Lindale, Texas and a member of VFW Post # 9828. His family includes his wife, Mary Lou of Lindale; sons, Michael of Tampa, FL and Thomas of Des Moines, IA; daughter, Susan Swanson of LeClair, IA; and 7 grandchildren. Gerry also leaves 4 step-children; Bonita Weber of Rockwell, IA, Marsha Westbrook of Des Moines, IA, Meanne Millang of Marble Rock, IA, and Fred Whipple of Mediapolis, IA. Also surviving is one sister, Sally Bailey of Perry, IA. His parents preceded him in death.
