Grady Carroll Poynter was born the youngest of eight children to Fay House and Fred S. Poynter on June 5, 1927 in Sachse, Texas. Grady passed away May 9, 2014 in Tyler, Texas. In addition to his parents, Grady was preceded in death by his wife of 47 years, Joyce Watson Poynter, Brother, Radford S. Poynter, Two Sisters, Juanita Henson and Hazel Thomas, and Brother, Bobby Poynter. Grady attended Forest High School in Dallas, Texas. After graduating, he joined the Navy where he served on a light cruiser, the Dayton, in the Pacific and Atlantic. Grady returned home and enrolled in the Texas Trade School and after two years graduated as a horologist and gemologist.
