Services for Mr. Grover C. Prince, age 87, of Hideaway, are scheduled for 2PM on Saturday, September 27, 2008, in the Hideaway Lake Community Church with Dr. Don Anderson, Rev. Jack Conley, & Bro. Herschel Sanders officiating. Entombment will follow in the Tyler Memorial Park Field of Honor Mausoleum under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale. Mr. Prince died on Wednesday, September 24, 2008 at the U.T. Health Science Center Hospital in Tyler, under Hospice Care. He was born on November 19, 1920 in Texarkana, to Cleve & Virgie Prince. Mr. Prince retired from United Transports as Regional Manager, then went to Green Cove Springs, Florida as President of Marine Fabricators, building off-shore work vessels. Because of the oil crunch, and after being there 3 years, he retired again and moved to his retirement home in Westwood Shores, Trinity, Texas. To get closer to family, he moved to Hideaway in 1991 and became a member of the Hideaway Community Church. He served in the US Army during WWII, in the European Theater for over 3 years participating in the D-Day Invasion and the Battle of the Bulge. In 2002 Mr. Prince was honored for being a Mason for 50 years.

Mr. Prince was preceded in death by his first wife of 30 years, Vena Marie, his parents, 3 Sisters, & 2 Brothers.
