Dr. Henry Keen Crawley, 89, of Hideaway passed away Friday, Aug. 24, 2007, in a Tyler Hospital. Memorial services will be 2 p.m. Monday, Aug. 27, in the Hide-a-Way Lake Community Church. Family will receive friends from 6 to 8 p.m. Sunday evening at the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale. Private graveside services were held in the Lindale City Cemetery under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Directors in Lindale.
