Funeral services for Mrs. Hilda M. "Mami" Gonzalez, age 77, of Lindale are scheduled for 10:00 A.M. Friday in the chapel of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale with Minister Alex Rodriguez officiating. Burial will follow at Lindale City Cemetery under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale.

Mrs. Gonzalez was born September 11, 1929 in Mexico and died Monday, January 22, 2007 in a Lindale nursing center. Formerly of Lubbock, she has lived in the East Texas area since 1973. She was a homemaker and a devout Jehovah's Witness.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Indalecio Gonzalez in 1974 and by a brother, Leonardo Martinez.

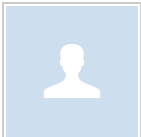

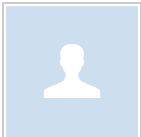

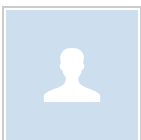
