



Hugh R. Motley

August 15, 1934 - October 18, 2003

Memorial services for Hugh R. Motley, age 69, of Hide-a-Way are scheduled for October 21, 2003 at 10:00 A.M. at the Hide-a-Way Lake Community Church near Tyler. Private graveside services will be held under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale.

Mr. Motley died October 18, 2003. He was born August 15, 1934 in Dallas County to the late Richard Motley and June McDearman Motley. He served in the U. S. Marine Corp during the Korean conflict, discharged as a Captain from the Marine Corps Reserve. He graduated from the University of Texas in 1961 with a degree in Accounting. He taught at the University while in graduate school. As a CPA, he worked for Arthur Young for 11 years. During this time he was elected to 2 terms as Mayor pro tem of the city of Mesquite. He also served as an Elder in the Presbyterian Church. In 1973, he joined Atlantic Richfield Company in the Tax Department. In 1992 he retired as Vice President and General Tax Officer of the Alaskan Company. While living in Alaska he was involved with the Republican Party as State Finance Chairman, Regional and District Chairman. He also served as a member of the Alaska Reapportionment Board and the State of Alaska Long Range Financial Planning Commission. He was a member of the Kenai Lake Baptist Church and served as Treasurer of the Alaska Conservative Baptist Association until moving to Hide-a-way in fall of 1996. In Hide-a-Way he was a member of Hide-a-Way Community Church serving on the Board as VP of

Finance for the last 4 years.

He is survived by his wife, Nancy Motley of Hide-a-Way; sons, Robert Motley and wife Constanza of Long Beach, CA; David Neal of Harper, Texas; Wayne Neal and wife Dedra of Paris, Texas; daughter, Martha Pulatie and husband James of Rockwall, Texas; sisters, Jerrie Smith of Las Vegas, NV; Becky Grisham of Mesquite, TX; brothers, David Motley of Garland, TX; Sam Motley & Joe Motley both of Mesquite; Mike Harrison of Dallas; Step-mother, Sammie Motley Coats of Mesquite; 10 grandchildren, 1 great grandchild; and neices and nephews.
