



Dr. James Kilkenney

April 26, 1937 - January 28, 2016

James Vail Kilkenney was born in Portland, Oregon on April 26, 1937 to James Bernard and Marjorie (Schlatter) Kilkenney. He was the brother of Kathleen Kilkenney-Moon, Mickey Damon, Ann Rothe, Pat Kilkenney, Tim Kilkenney, and the late Barney Kilkenney.

In addition to Barbara, his beloved wife of 39 years, he is survived by his five sons—Jamie Kilkenney of Kona, Hawaii; John Kilkenney of Kona, Hawaii; Daniel Kilkenney of Pleasanton, CA; Marty Kilkenney of Davis, CA; and Robert Kilkenney of Tyler and his six daughters—Marta Morando of Santa Barbara, CA; Agnes Kilkenney of Tyler; Alina Shipman of Lindale; Joan Kilkenney of Tyler; Amy Katherine Kilkenney of Tyler; and Joana Ahn of Tyler. He was blessed with twenty-five grandchildren who brought great joy to his heart.

In 1978, after years as a public school teacher, Mr. Kilkenney joined the international mission agency Youth With A Mission, confident that his days in the classroom were over. However, scarcely a year passed when he and Mrs. Kilkenney (also a former teacher) understood that God was directing them back to the classroom. Their call? Establish a Christian school, a school dedicated to building faith by laying God's Word as the foundation of all teaching. Obedient to God's voice, the Kilkenneys founded Christian Heritage School (CHS) in 1979.

Convinced that God's truth had power—power to transform individuals and nations, Mr. Kilkenney launched Teachers for the Nations, a training school to equip teachers who would serve at CHS and who would start Christian schools internationally. Christian Heritage School provided the place where these teachers-in-training would gain valuable experience by working with classroom teachers. The school began in 1980—with two students!

Undeterred, Mr. Kilkenney faithfully obeyed God's call and patiently sowed the seeds of His truth. He sowed them again and again. And God gave the increase. More than 400 came from 40 nations. They sat the feet of this master teacher and learned about the fear of the Lord. They witnessed the power of humility and beheld the beauty of mercy. They experienced the love of a father and received the kindness of a friend.

And what of the hundreds who came? They are starting schools, planting churches, strengthening families, discipling children, and training more teachers. The hundreds are reaching thousands, many thousands around the world. All this because Mr. Kilkenney was

a humble man who gave himself unreservedly to do the will of God.
