Janet Lynn Alford, of Hideaway, Texas, died on Monday, November 21, 2006.

Jan was born in Houston, Texas on October 2, 1953. At an early age, she was drawn to the theatre, and became an accomplished singer and actress. She began appearing in school plays and local dinner theatre during her high school years. She then joined the New Christy Minstrels in 1972, touring the world during the years she sang with the popular folk group. She was the lead singer of several successful bands in Australia and Texas during the 1970s. Later, she was a cast member in the long-running Las Vegas edition of "The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas."

Jan also had a successful career in marketing and apartment leasing in Houston before moving to Hideaway to care for her mother during an illness. She continued to live and work in the Tyler area until her death.

Jan is survived by her mother, Helen Morgan Alford; her father Dr. Jack Alford; her brothers, Jack, James, and Jay; two half-siblings, Zoe and Jonathan; two nephews, and a niece.
