June 21, 1930 - July 1, 2015

A celebration of the life of Mr. Jesse L. Baker, age 85 of Lindale, Texas are scheduled for 10:00 AM Saturday, July 4, 2015 at Christ Central Church in Lindale with Rev. Raymond Burroughs, Rev. Mr. Baker died Wednesday, July 1, 2015 at a Tyler Hospice facility.
