Funeral services for Mr. Jesse R. Nolley, age 62, of Hideaway are scheduled for 2:00 P.M. He was born November 11, 1943 in Provenal, Louisiana to Henry W. and Effie Mae Hawthorne Nolley and was formerly of Dallas and North Carolina before moving to Hideaway in 2001. Mr. Nolley served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War, was a member of the Hide-a-Way Lake Community Church, and worked as a machinist for Proctor & Gamble, retiring in 1999.
