June 23, 1925 - January 13, 2015

John Henry Hulsey, age 89, passed away at his Tyler home, after a short illness, on January 13, 2015. Graveside services will be held at 1:00 P.M. Friday, January 16, 2015 in the Hopewell Cemetery under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale, Texas. The family will receive friends from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. prior to the graveside service at the Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home.

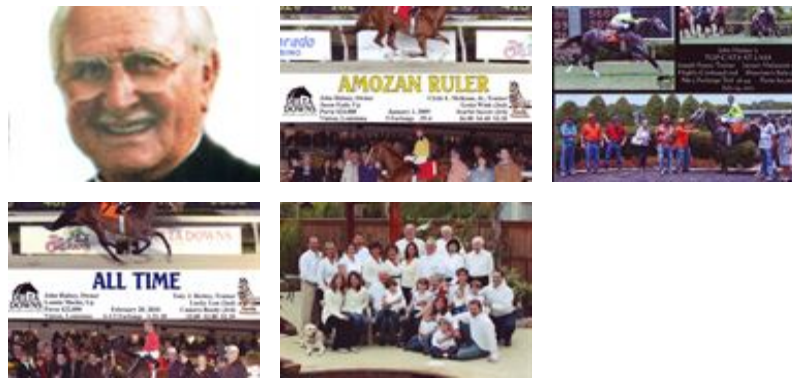
