Funeral services for John Wesley McGregor, age 44, of Lindale are scheduled for 3:00 P.M. Saturday, May 22, 2010 at the Fellowship of Prairie Creek Church in Lindale with Pastor Steven Charles officiating. Interment will follow in the Sabine Cemetery under the direction of Caudle-Rutledge Funeral Home in Lindale.

Mr. McGregor was born in Jacksonville, Texas on March 11, 1966, the son of Johnny Russell and Ann (West) McGregor. He passed away Tuesday, May 18, 2010. Mr. McGregor grew up and graduated from Maydelle High School and has lived in Lindale for the past 19 years. He was an active member and Elder of the Fellowship of Prairie Creek Church. Mr. McGregor worked for Mother Frances Hospital beginning in 1986, becoming a Flight Nurse in 1989. He worked for Mother Frances Hospital for 13 years before going to work for East Texas Medical Center as a Flight Nurse/Paramedic.

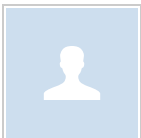
