



## Lance Kennemer

December 17, 1959 - April 22, 2021

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, April 27th to honor the life of Gary “Lance” Kennemer, 61, of Winona, at Caudle-Rutledge-Daugherty Funeral Home in Lindale, with Bro. Mike Ford and Bro. Bill Vickery officiating. Family will receive friends from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. prior to the service. Lance left this world and entered heaven to meet his Lord and Savior on April 22, 2021.

Lance was born December 17, 1959 in Big Spring, TX to Edwin Max and Barbara Jean Kennemer.

Lance made the decision to accept Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior as a young boy at Calvary Baptist Church in Tyler.

Lance graduated from John Tyler High School in 1978 and married his wife, Sissy of 42 years, in April 1979, at the age of 19.

Lance began his career at the young age of 17, as an independent milk hauler and later went to work for Brookshire’s Manufacturing Company.
