Funeral services for Mr. Leon McLemore, age 75, of Hideaway are scheduled for 10:00 A.M. Thursday, August 28, 2008 at the Hideaway Lake Community Church with Rev. Jack Conley officiating. Interment will be held in the Dallas/Ft. Worth National Cemetery at 9:30 a.m. Friday, August 29, 2008. Mr. McLemore died Sunday, August 24, 2008 in a Tyler hospice center. Mr. McLemore was formerly of Waxahachie and Irving before moving to Hideaway 15 years ago.
