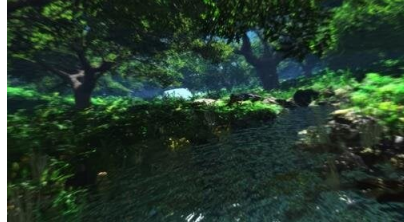
members and friends.

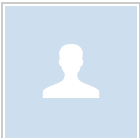

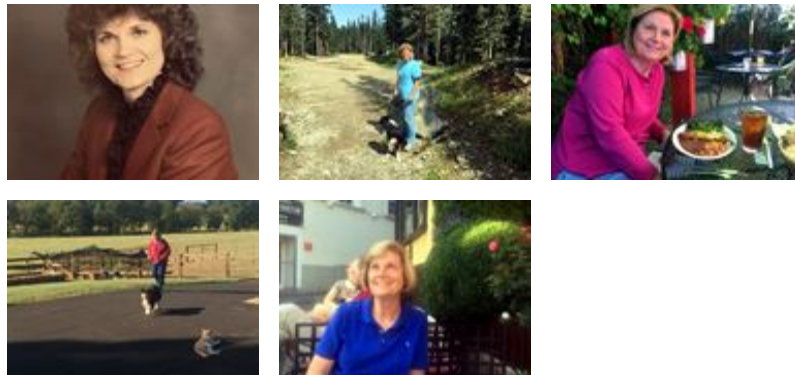
